

## Robot Design Workshop

We worked through two sessions, five days of fun in the month of August, where young makers took an original prototype and iteratively added features and function. Working from digital design, makers used the laser, 3d printers, some basic electronics, soldering, and microcontrollers to make improvements to their pen bots.

The robotics program is available to share with any group that has the time and interest, but otherwise look for the program event again next summer.



Participants lasered name cards, with skills badges added as earned. To earn a badge, kids present projects that show off their new skill. This is available to kids anytime at CVM, but it is also a great introduction project to the laser for anyone. 


Pictured Below: Donation options you will see when signed in as a CVM member
